


















FIGURE 9 ~ 14





























FIGURE 20 ~ 25




















組裝前請確認所有部件已經齊全,如有遺漏,請與代理商聯繫。 本產品無需工具進行組裝。

## 保養維護與保固

- 1.清洗座布時,請使用30度以下水溫清洗,請勿漂白。
- 2. 清洗車架: 僅能使用中性清潔劑及溫水洗滌,請勿使用漂白劑。
- 3. 隨時檢查您的手推車,並隨時更換或修理鬆弛磨損的零件、脫落的材料或 車縫線。
- 4. 過度曝曬於陽光下,可導致手推車老化或變形。
- 5. 手推車潮濕時,請打開手推車及遮陽篷,待乾燥後再收合起來。
- 6. 如果輪子發出"吱吱"聲,可加油(WD-40,防鏽油或縫紉機油)潤滑。請將 潤滑油點入輪軸及軸孔(圖3)之間,此步驟為重要的保養須知。
- 7. 在海邊使用手推車時,務必於使用過後清除沙粒,以做好完善的清洗。

## 產品組裝

組裝及使用手推車前,請先閱讀說明書全文,並按照說明書指示進行操作。

#### 打開手推車

推開收合鉤( $\mathbb{S}_4$ ),然後將車手向上拉起( $\mathbb{S}_5$ ),聽到"咔噠"聲表示車架已打開到位。

! 使用手推車前務必確保車架已打開到位。

#### 安裝前輪

將前輪套入前腳,聽到"咔噠"聲表示前輪已安裝到位(圖6) 分開前輪釋鎖片(圖7.1),同時向下拉前輪(圖7.2),即可拔出前輪。

#### 安裝後輪

將後輪插入後輪固定座,聽到"咔噠"聲表示後輪已安裝到位(圖8) 按壓後輪釋鎖按鈕(圖9.1),同時向外拉出後輪(圖9.2),即可拔出後輪。

#### 安裝扶手

安裝扶手,將扶手卡槽對准扶手固定座插入即可(圖10)

拆卸扶手,按壓扶手兩側的釋鎖按鈕(圖11.1),同時向外拉扶手即可(圖11.2) 手推車組裝完成後如圖12所示。

## 產品操作

#### 調整背靠角度

1. 調低背靠角度

按壓背靠調整器上的調整按鈕,同時向下旋轉背靠到合適的角度(圖13)

- !如寶寶已坐在座椅內,請用另一隻手輕托背靠,以減少震盪。
- ! 背靠完全躺平時,遮陽篷後片與背靠必須用黏扣帶黏合。
- 2. 調高背靠角度

向後拉背靠調整織帶,同時將背靠向上推即可(圖14)

! 確保背靠角度調整到合適角度後,方可使用。

#### 使用安全扣

#### 鬆開安全扣

按下母扣中央的按鈕, 鬆開安全扣(圖15)

#### 扣合安全扣

將腰帶扣依次插入肩帶扣(圖16.1)和母扣內(圖16.2),聽到"咔噠"聲表示扣合到位(圖16.3)

- ! 為防止寶寶摔跤,寶寶乘坐時必須繫上安全帶。
- !請牢牢地繫上安全帶,並注意寶寶與安全帶之間須可以放進一個手掌的厚度。
- ! 請勿交叉肩帶,以免對寶寶頸部造成壓迫。

#### 使用肩帶和腰帶

· 實實坐進手推車後,請確認肩帶孔高度和肩帶及腰帶的長度是否合適, 以免實實於使用時意外跌出。

■17.1 肩帶固定栓A

圖17.3 調整扣

較大的寶寶使用時,請使用肩帶固定栓A和最上方的肩帶孔;

較小的寶寶使用時,請使用肩帶固定栓B和最下方的肩帶孔。

調整肩帶固定栓位置時,將背靠後方的肩帶固定栓放置水平、短邊朝前,從肩帶孔穿出(圖18),再從背靠前方將肩帶固定栓穿過最接近寶寶肩膀的 肩帶孔(圖19)

將調整扣上下滑動,可調節肩帶長度(600.1);按壓按鈕(600.2),同時往外拉安全扣內側或外側的腰帶,可調節腰帶長度(600.3)

#### 使用肩帶護片

肩帶護片可直接從肩帶上取下,反之即可組裝。請將肩帶護片寬面朝向 會會, 辦免影響會會的舒適性。

#### 使用頭靠

打開安全扣,可將頭靠沿肩帶取下。反之則可組裝頭靠。

#### 調節小腿靠支撐板

依不同使用需求,小腿靠共有2個段位可供調節。

段位調高時,將小腿靠支撐板由下往上推即可。

段位調低時,按壓小腿靠兩側的調整按鈕(600021.1),同時向下調節小腿靠支撐板(60021.2)

#### 前輪定向

鎖定時,按下拉板(圖22),即可固定車輪前行方向。

釋鎖時,向上提起拉板,車輪可自由轉向,改變推行方向更容易。

使用小秘訣 當在碎石路面或不平路面推行時,建議鎖定前輪,便能更輕鬆 地操控手推車。

#### 使用剎車踏板

準備剎車時,踩下剎車踏板(圖23),即可完成剎車動作。 打開剎車時,向上提起剎車踏板(圖24),即可完成釋鎖動作。

使用小秘訣 手推車停止前進時,請鎖定剎車踏板。

#### 使用遮陽篷

打開或者收攏遮陽篷,將遮陽篷往前拉或往後翻即可。

防止實實被陽光直射,可以完全打開遮陽篷,拉開拉鏈(<mark>圖25-1)</mark>,將遮陽篷往前拉即可。

可從遮陽篷上的窗戶確認寶寶狀態

將遮陽篷後片往上捲起並用黏扣帶固定住即可看到寶寶(圖25-2)

! 遮陽篷後片口袋不可置物超過0.5kg。

#### 收合手推車

收合手推車前,請先收攏遮陽篷。

按壓釋鎖按鈕(圖26.1)再向上提起收合織帶(圖26.2),車架向後自動折疊(圖26)收合鉤自動扣合收合栓,手推車收合完成後如圖26.3所示。

#### 使用配件

圖27.1 雨篷 圖27.2 蚊帳

蚊帳為選購配件。

因產品型號的不同,並非所有手推車均附以上配件。

#### 使用汽車椅

因產品型號的不同規格會有所不同,並非所有手推車均可以卡合Joie汽車椅 gemm。

將汽車椅置於手推車內,以使汽車椅卡鉤卡到扶手邊緣,汽車椅將自動扣合到 位(圖28)

- ! 使用汽車椅前,請確保靠背已調至最低位置,並且汽車椅已確實固定。
- ! 用手推車兩側的固定織帶固定汽車椅(圖29)
- ! 請勿收合已安裝汽車椅的手推車。

移除汽車椅時,先從汽車椅上取下固定織帶,按壓汽車椅釋鎖把手,同時從 手推車內提出汽車椅即可(圖30)

! 關於使用汽車椅有任何問題,請參考汽車椅說明書。

#### 使用雨篷

將雨篷套到車架上,再黏合雨篷側面的黏扣帶(圖31)

- ! 使用雨篷時,請確認汽車椅已正確固定和推車背靠已調至最低檔。
- ! 使用雨篷時,請隨時注意並確認雨篷內有良好的通風。
- ! 不使用雨篷時,請先確認雨篷已清潔並乾燥,再收納。
- ! 請勿收合已罩上雨篷的手推車。
- ! 天氣炎熱時,請勿將幼童放在裝有雨篷的手推車內。

#### 使用蚊帳

將蚊帳套在車架上,並依以下步驟固定蚊帳(圖32):

- 1. 將蚊帳一端通過鬆緊帶套在腳踏板下方。
- 2. 將蚊帳另一端通過鬆緊帶套在遮陽篷後片上。
- ! 蚊帳可配合下列兩種情況使用 手推車單獨使用 手推車配合汽車椅使用
- ! 手推車配合汽車椅使用時,背靠必須在最低位置。



This product is a high-quality and fully functional stroller, approved to Taiwan safety standards CNS 12940:2013 and European safety standards EN 1888-1:2018+A1:2022. It is suitable for a child weighing under 15kg (0-36 months).

Read these instructions carefully before use and keep them for future reference. Your child's safety may be affected if you do not follow these instructions.

The figures in this manual are to illustrate the operating methods and product main features.

This model may have differences between features shown. The figures are just for reference.

### **WARNINGS**

- Never leave the child unattended.
- ! Use the stroller with only one child at a time. Never place purses, shopping bags, parcels or accessory items on the handle or canopy.
- ! Overload, fold incorrectly or use it along with component parts from other manufacturers may cause the stroller to be damaged, broken or unsafe.
- ! Always use the restraint system. Safety belts and restraint system must be used correctly.
- Make sure your child's body is clear from the moving parts when adjusting the stroller.
- Never use stroller on stairs or escalators.
- Never allow your child to stand on the stroller or sit in the stroller with head toward front of stroller.
- Keep away from fire source, high temperature objects, liquids, and electronics.
- Never place the stroller on roads, slopes or dangerous area.
- Do not lift stroller whilst child is in it.
- Adult assembly required.
- Use of the stroller with a child weighing less than 15kg. It will cause damage to the stroller with an unfitted child.
- ! Always use the crotch combination with the waist belt. It is suggested that the shoulder harnesses be used as well.
- To prevent a hazardous, unstable condition, do not place more than 4.5kg in the storage basket.
- Please read all the instructions in this manual before using the product. Please save instruction manual for future use. Failure to follow these warnings and instructions may result in serious injury or death.
- Child may slip into leg openings and be strangled if the harness is not used.
- ! Ensure that all the locking devices are engaged before use.

- Accessories which are not approved by the manufacturer shall not be used. Only replacement parts supplied or recommended by the manufacturer shall be used.
- Avoid strangulation, do not place items with a string around your child's neck, suspend strings from this product, or attach strings to toys.
- Any load attached to the handle or on the back of the backrest or on the sides of the stroller will affect the stability of the stroller.
- Do not use storage basket as a child carrier.
- ! To prevent tipping, never let child climb the stroller.
- ! To avoid injury, ensure that the child is kept away when unfolding and folding this product.
- Be sure the stroller is fully open or folded before allowing child near the stroller.
- ! To ensure your child's safety, please make sure all parts are assembled and fastened properly before using the stroller.
- ! Avoid strangulation, do make sure your child is clear from the canopy.
- Always engage the brakes when parking the stroller.
- Discontinue using your stroller if it is damaged or broken.
- ! This product is not suitable for running or skating. It is intended to be used only at walking speed.
- ! To avoid suffocation, remove plastic bag and packaging materials before using this product. The plastic bag and packaging materials should then be destroyed or kept away from babies and children.
- It is recommended the use of the most reclined position for new born baby.
- Do not let the child play with this product.
- ! The parking device should be engaged when placing and removing your child.
- ! Check that the infant child restraint attachment devices are correctly engaged before use.
- For infant child restraints used in conjunction with a chassis, this vehicle does not replace a cot or a bed. Should your child need to sleep, then it should be placed in a suitable pram body, cot or bed.

## **Emergency**

In case of emergency or accidents, it is most important to have your child taken care of with first aid and medical treatment immediately.

Make sure all parts are available before assembly. If any part is missing, please contact local distributor.

No tools are required for assembly.

### **Care and Maintenance**

- Removable seat pad may be washed in cold water and drip-dried.
   No bleach.
- 2. To clean stroller frame, use only household soap and warm water. No bleach or detergent.
- 3. From time to time, check your stroller for loose screws, worn parts, torn material or stitching. Replace or repair the parts as needed.
- 4. Excessive exposure to sun or heat could cause fading or warping of parts.
- 5. If stroller becomes wet, open canopy and allow to dry thoroughly before storing.
- 6. If wheels squeak, use a light oil (e.g., WD-40, antirust oil, or sewing machine oil). It is important to get the oil into the axle and wheel assembly. (Fig. 3)
- 7. When using your stroller at the beach, completely clean your stroller afterward to remove sand and salt from mechanisms and wheel assemblies.

## **Stroller Assembly**

Please read all the instructions in this manual before assembling and using this product.

#### **Open Stroller**

Separate storage latch from storage mount (Fig. 4), and then lift the handle upwards (Fig. 5), a click sound means the stroller is open completely.

! Check that the stroller is completely open before continuing.

#### **Assemble Front Wheel**

Assemble front wheel to front leg. Check that the front wheel is securely attached by pulling on wheel assembly. (Fig. 6)

To disassemble front wheel, detach front wheel from front leg (Fig. 7.2) while pressing the release tabs outwards. (Fig. 7.1)

#### **Assemble Rear Wheels**

Align the axle of the rear wheel with the rear wheel mount, and then insert to assemble the rear wheel (Fig. 8). Check that wheels are securely attached by pulling on wheel assemblies.

To disassemble rear wheel, detach rear wheel from rear wheel mount (Fig. 9.2) while pressing the release button. (Fig. 9.1)

#### **Assemble Armbar**

Align the armbar end slider with matching fixing slot, and then insert to lock. (Fig. 10)

To disassemble armbar, press armbar release button (Fig. 11.1), and then pull up the armbar. (Fig. 11.2)

The completely assembled stroller is shown as Fig. 12

## **Stroller Operation**

#### **Adjust Backrest**

Recline Backrest

Pull the backrest backwards, while pressing the button in the center of the angle adjuster. (Fig. 13)

! The canopy must be fixed by hook and loop fastener on the backrest when the backrest in flat position.

Raise Backrest

Push the backrest forwards, while pulling the webbing at the end of the angle adjuster. (Fig. 14.1)

! Make sure the recline is set properly for use.

#### **Use Buckle**

Release Buckle

Press the center button to release the buckle. (Fig. 15)

Lock Buckle

Match the waist belt buckle with the shoulder buckle (Fig. 16.1), and click into the center buckle. (Fig. 16.2) A "click" sound means the buckle is locked completely. (Fig. 16.3)

- ! To avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out, always secure your child with harness.
- ! Make sure your child is snugly secured. The space between the child and the shoulder harness is about the thickness of one hand.
- ! Do not cross the shoulder belts. This will cause pressure on child's neck.

#### **Use Shoulder & Waist Harnesses**

! In order to protect your child from falling out, after your child is placed into the seat, check whether the shoulder and waist harnesses are at proper height and length.

Fig. 17.3 Slide adjuster

To adjust the position of the shoulder harness anchor, turn the anchor to be level with the side facing forward. Thread it through the shoulder harness slot from back to front. (Fig. 18) Rethread it through the slot that is closest to child's shoulder height. (Fig. 19)

Use slide adjuster to change the harness length. (Fig. 20.1)

Press the button (Fig. 20.2), while pulling the waist harness to proper length. (Fig. 20.3)

#### **Use Shoulder Harness Cover**

The shoulder harness cover can be removed from the webbing.

To assemble shoulder harness cover in reverse steps.

#### **Use Head Support**

The head support can be removed from the webbing. To assemble head support in reverse steps.

#### **Adjust Calf Support**

The calf support has 2 positions.

Raise Calf Support

To raise the calf support, just push it upwards. A "click" sound means the calf support is locked completely.

Lower Calf Support

Press the adjustment buttons on both sides of the calf support (Fig. 21.1), and rotate the calf support downwards. (Fig. 21.2)

#### **Use Front Swivel Lock**

Push down the front swivel locks to maintain the moving direction. (Fig. 22)

Tip It is recommended to use swivel locks on uneven surfaces.

#### **Use Brake**

To lock wheels, step the brake lever downwards. (Fig. 23)

To release wheels, just lift the brake lever upwards. (Fig. 24)

Tip Always apply brake when stroller is in stopped position.

#### **Use Canopy**

The canopy can be opened or folded, pull it toward front or back.

The canopy can be opened completely to protect your child from the sun uttermostly, just unzip the canopy (Fig. 25-1), and then pull the canopy toward front.

Roll up the backward panel and stick the hook and loop fastener, then you can view your baby. (Fig. 25-2)

! Total Maximum Weight of hood storage pocket MUST not exceed 0.5 kg.

#### **Fold Stroller**

! Please fold the canopy before folding the stroller.

Press releasing button. (Fig. 26.1) Pull the folding webbing upward (Fig. 26.2), the frame will automatically fold backward. (Fig. 26)

The storage latch will automatically hook onto the storage mount, then the stroller is folded and locked completely. (Fig. 26.3)

#### **Use Accessories**

The mosquito net is optional accessories.

Not all accessories are included on some models.

#### Use with Joie Infant Child Restraint

Not all accessories are included on some models. Not all the strollers can be attached Joie Infant Child Restraint Gemm.

Place infant child restraint into stroller so notches in rockers fit over edge of armbar. The infant child restraint will then automatically click into place. (Fig. 28)

- ! Before using the infant child restraint, please make sure the backrest has been adjusted to the lowest position and the infant child restraint has been fastened.
- ! Use the straps on both sides of stroller to fix the child restraint. (Fig. 29)
- ! Please don't fold stroller when attaching the infant child restraint.

To remove the infant child restraint, release the straps from the infant child restraint, pull up the stroller release handle to release the infant child restraint from armbar, and then lift infant child restraint out of stroller. Please refer to (Fig. 30)

! If you have any problems about using the infant child restraint, please refer to their own instruction manuals.

#### **Use Rain Cover**

To assemble the rain cover, place it over the stroller, and then attach the hook and loop fasteners on the rain cover. (Fig. 31)

- ! Before using the rain cover, please make sure the backrest has been adjusted to the lowest position and the infant child restraints has been fastened.
- ! When using the rain cover, please always check its ventilation.
- ! When not in use, please check that the rain cover has been cleaned and dried before folding.
- ! Do not fold the stroller after assembling the rain cover.
- ! Do not place your child into the stroller assembled with rain cover during hot weather.

#### **Use Mosquito Net**

Cover the mosquito net on the frame, and fixed it per following steps. (Fig. 32)

- Cover the one end of the mosquito net on the bottom of footrest by elastic band.
- 2. Cover the other end of the mosquito net on the canopy rear panel by elastic band.
  - ! Use the mosquito net on following two status:
    - Use the stroller only.
    - Use the stroller with infant child restraint.
  - ! The recline must be on the lowest position when using the stroller with the infant child restraint.

### Note
